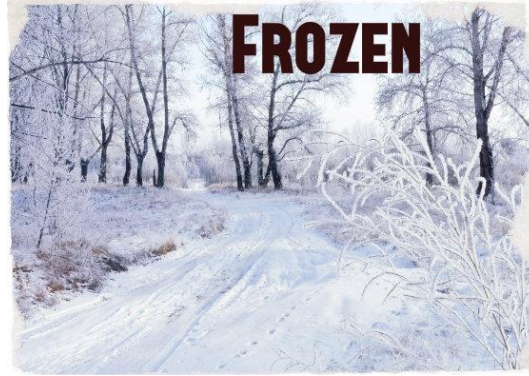


Frozen
