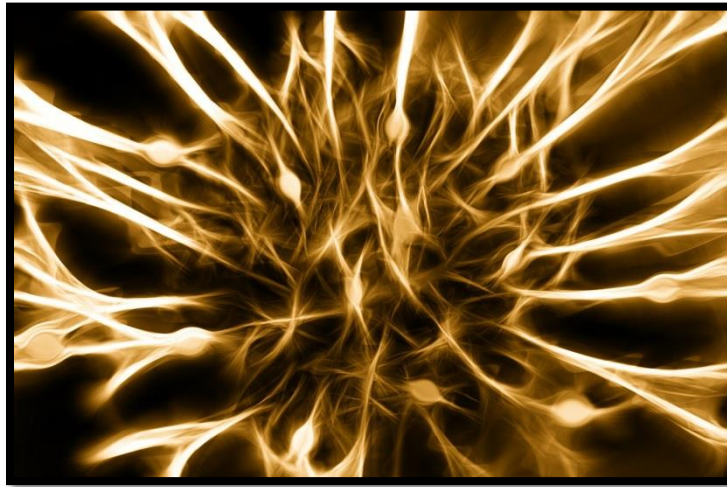


The Montreal Procedure
